JUDGMENT OF THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNAL

The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal delivered orally with reasons on 6 April 2018 was that:-

- (1) The respondent made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages contrary to Section 13 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 and is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £5,463 (Five Thousand, Four Hundred and Sixty Three Pounds) in respect thereof.
- 40 (2) The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant one week's statutory notice pay in the sum of £585 (Five Hundred and Eighty Five Pounds).

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(3) In consequence of the claimant succeeding in claims of a kind mentioned in Schedule 5 of the Employment Act 2002 and the respondent having failed to issue the claimant with a written statement of employment particulars as required by section 1 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant four weeks' pay, that is £2,340 (Two Thousand, Three Hundred and Forty Pounds).
