JUDGMENT OF THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNAL

The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £1,700 (One 30 Thousand, Seven Hundred Pounds) being the figure agreed between the parties as being due to the claimant in respect of breach of contract, non-payment of money in respect of the notice period due to the claimant.

REASONS

- 1. In this case there was a Preliminary Hearing held on 10 May 2017. The parties appeared at that Preliminary Hearing.
- 40 2. In course of the Preliminary Hearing it was confirmed by both parties that the respondent was due to pay to the claimant money in respect of the period of notice which ought to have been worked by the claimant. It was agreed that the sum due was £1,700. The respondents undertook to make

payment of that sum. This is recorded in a note of the Preliminary Hearing which was issued on 17 May 2017.

3. Notwithstanding this agreement, the sum of £1,700 has not been paid by the respondents to the claimant. There has been no communication by the respondents to the Tribunal disputing liability for this amount.

4. The claimant has sought a Judgment ordering the respondents to pay the agreed sum to him. In the circumstances narrated this Judgment is therefore issued. The respondents are ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £1,700 being the agreed amount in respect of notice.
