JUDGMENT

REASONS

- The claim was listed for a Preliminary Hearing by telephone on 21 September 2017. The claimant did not contact the Tribunal by telephone at the allocated time. The Preliminary Hearing was adjourned in the absence of the claimant
- 2 On 21 September 2017 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 29 September 2017 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
- 3 The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
