## Financial Notice to improve: Washwood Heath Multi Academy Trust

On 10 November 2020, I wrote to your predecessor in their capacity as the Chair of Trustees at Washwood Heath Multi Academy Trust to serve notice that Washwood Heath Multi Academy Trust (`the trust`) was required to improve the financial management and governance at the trust.

This was as a consequence of an ESFA investigation of the trust which established a number of breaches of the Academies Financial Handbook (AFH) in respect of related party transactions, governance arrangements, external and internal audit, procurement and expense claims. The Financial Notice to Improve (FNtI) set out the actions that were needed to be taken by the trust to make sure necessary improvements were made.

We have closely monitored the trust's progress against the conditions set out in the notice, which included all related party transactions being pre-approved by ESFA, the trust board having the appropriate skill sets to hold the executive management team to account, a robust procurement policy, submitting a trust financial plan and updating the scheme of delegation. I am pleased to inform you that I am satisfied that the FNtI conditions have been met. As a result, the FNtI will be lifted with effect from the date of this letter.

This letter will be published on the GOV.UK website. I am copying this letter to Peter Weir, Accounting Officer of the trust and Andrew Warren, Regional Schools Commissioner for the West Midlands.

It is important that the trust continues to embed the controls and processes which have led to this improvement and exercise strong oversight. I would like to thank you for your contribution in ensuring the trust has reached this position.
