Thank you for your email of 26 January 2022 to the Ministry of Defence (MOD) requesting the following information:

*"I am trying to retrieve information of death in service of all service members from two parish areas in Buckinghamshire. The information I need is as follows.* 

From 2nd September 1945 until present day.

Area 1 = Iver, Buckinghamshire, England Area 2 = Iver Heath, Buckinghamshire, England.

Deaths in service of members of all forces:-

Army Navy Royal Air Force."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

In the period 1 January 1948 to 31 December 2021, there was **one** death among UK Armed Forces personnel who was identified as <u>having a birthplace</u> in the parish area of Iver or Iver Heath, Buckinghamshire recorded on their death certificate. The details of this individual are:
