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JUDGMENT OF THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNAL

1. The claim, insofar as it relates to holiday pay and one week worked, is dismissed.

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REASONS

This case was set down for a Hearing on 8 March 2018 to determine the claims for arrears of pay, holiday pay, notice pay, one week worked and sick pay. The claimant appeared, unrepresented. The respondent did not appear.

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The claimant was provided with a copy of documents which the respondent had previously provided to the Tribunal. After reviewing those documents, the claimant informed the Tribunal that she was no longer proceeding with her

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claims in respect of holiday pay and one week worked. The claimant stated that she had been paid the appropriate amounts.

- 3 The claimant informed the Tribunal that she was withdrawing those claims.

- The claims in respect of arrears of pay, notice pay and sick pay shall continue.
