JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d)

REASONS

1. The tribunal wrote to the claimant on 09 March 2017 and then again on the 23 March 2017 asking her to confirm if she was representing herself or if she intended to seek new representation after the withdrawal of her appointed representative.
2. On 06 April 2017 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 27 April 2017 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
3. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
