JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant is found to have transferred to employment of the first respondent by way of TUPE transfer on 12.10.21.
- 2. The Claimants claim for redundancy pay against the first respondent succeeds.
- 3. The first respondent (Bespoke Cleaning Services Ltd) must pay a redundancy payment of £10,920 to the claimant within 28 days of this Judgment.
- 4. It is just and equitable to make a costs order against the second respondent (Nicole Cooper trading as Diamond Flooring) of £5460 in respect of the redundancy award. The Second respondent shall pay the said sum to the first respondent within 28 days of this order.
