- 1. The Claimant was an employee of the Respondent from November 2015 to his dismissal by the Respondent on 25 July 2020.
- 2. The Claimant's claim for notice pay succeeds and the Respondent is Ordered to pay £1,360, subject to deductions.
- 3. The Claimant's claim for unlawful deductions succeeds and the Respondent is Ordered to pay 18 weeks' pay at £340 a week, which is £6,120 gross.
- 4. The Claimant's claim for holiday pay succeeds. Based on the Claimant's weekly pay at the relevant times, he is entitled to, and the Respondent is Ordered to pay: a. 4.2 weeks pay for the 2019/2020 holiday year, which is £1,428 gross
 - b. 4 weeks pay for the 2018/2019 holiday year, which is £1,360 gross
 - c. 4 weeks pay for the 2017/2018 holiday year, which is £1,280 gross
 - d. 4 weeks pay for the 2016/2017 holiday year, which is \pounds 1,200 gross
 - e. 4 weeks pay for the 2015/2016 holiday year, which is £1,120 gross.
