## JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37(1)(d) of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued.

## REASONS

On 16 July 2019 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 22 July 2019 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out. The concern was that it was not being actively pursued. The claimant had failed to attend a hearing on 21 June 2019, had not completed a case

management agenda and had not complied with an order to explain his failure to attend by 1 July 2019.

The claimant also failed to reply to the letter of 16 July 2019, and therefore failed to give an acceptable reason why the claim should not be struck out or to request a hearing. I therefore strike out the claim on the basis that it has not been actively pursued.
