JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d)

REASONS

1. On 29 October 2018 the Tribunal wrote to the Claimant enclosing a copy of a response form and accompanying letter from the Respondent advising that the claim has been settled. The Claimant was asked to provide comments by 9 November 2018. None were received from the Claimant despite a further reminder on 14 November 2018.
2. On 20 November 2018 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 23 November 2018 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
3. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
