JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d)

REASONS

- 1. On 29 October 2018 the Tribunal wrote to the Claimant enclosing a copy of a response form and accompanying letter from the Respondent advising that the claim has been settled. The Claimant was asked to provide comments by 9 November 2018. None were received from the Claimant despite a further reminder on 14 November 2018.
- On 20 November 2018 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 23 November 2018 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
- The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
