JUDGMENT

EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNAL'S RULES OF PROCEDURE 2013 RULE 21

Region in which the claim was presented: Midlands (East)

Date the claim was presented: **17 November 2021**

The respondent has failed to present a response in accordance with the Tribunal's rules and orders. Therefore, the claimant is entitled to a judgment in default on their claims.

After considering the Tribunal file and the documents supplied by the claimant, the Tribunal's judgment is as follows:

1. The respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages. The respondent **must** pay to the claimant the **gross** sum of **£673.05**.
2. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement. The respondent **must** pay to the claimant the **gross** sum of **£663.44**.
3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice. The respondent **must** pay damages to the claimant in the sum of **£480.75**.
4. All further hearings are cancelled
