## **JUDGMENT**

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d).

## **REASONS**

- 1. The claimant did not appear and was not represented at the preliminary hearing on 17 April 2019. There was no contact and no explanation for this failure.
- On 17 April 2019 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 01 May 2019 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out
- The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
