JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim (or the part struck out) has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d)

REASONS

The claimant was requested to provide further information about their claim at a Preliminary Hearing on 14 October 2017. He has failed to do so despite numerous urgent correspondence and having been given the opportunity to progress their claim.

- On 12 December 2018 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 18 January 2019 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim or part of the claim should not be struck out.
- The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
