JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d).

REASONS

- 1, On 10 May 2019, the Tribunal wrote to the Claimant requesting additional information about his claim. There was no reply. A reminder was sent on 23 May 2019 asking if the claims were being pursued. No reply was received.

- 2 On 17 June 2019 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 01 July 2019 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.

- 3 The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
