REGULATION (EU) 2018/848 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL OF 30 MAY 2018 ON ORGANIC PRODUCTION AND LABELLING OF ORGANIC PRODUCTS AND REPEALING COUNCIL REGULATION (EC) NO 834/2007

SUBJECT MATTER

- 1. Regulation (EU) 2018/848 sets out the rules on production, certification, labelling and advertising of organic food and feed. It applies to any organic products which are produced, processed, packed or imported in the EU or Northern Ireland.
- 2. Regulation (EU) 2018/848 came into force on 1 January 2022, repealing the previous Council Regulation (EC) 834/2007.
- 3. The implementation of Regulation 2018/848 was delayed by a year due to the disruption caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, as set out in the Explanatory Memorandum COM (20) 483.
- 4. Through the action of the Withdrawal Agreement and the Protocol on Ireland/Northern Ireland, Regulation 2018/848 now applies in Northern Ireland, while retained Regulation 834/2007 continues to apply in Great Britain, creating divergence. The Trade and Cooperation Agreement recognises the EU and UK as equivalent for the purpose of trade in organic products so there is no impact for GB/EU trade.
- 5. Regulation 2018/848 is the new "basic act" for EU organics. The delegated acts and implementing acts set out the detailed technical rules (see Annex B). Many of the requirements remain unchanged from the previous legislation, or have been subjected to minor alterations or clarifications. However, there are also some more substantial changes as outlined in points 6-15 below, as based on Soil Association's published guidance.

- 6. **Transition period** goods produced before 1 January 2022 may continue to be marketed as organic until stocks run out.
- 7. **Certification** operators will need to be issued with a new certificate referencing Regulation 2018/848. An operator may not be certified by 2 different organic certification bodies for the same category of products in the same country.
- 8. Cleaning and disinfection products the list of products permitted for use in cleaning and disinfection of buildings and equipment is restricted. This list is still being developed and implementing regulation 2021/1165 permits operators to use existing cleaning and disinfectant products until 31 December 2023.
- 9. Non-organic inputs The list of permitted non-organic agricultural ingredients is considerably reduced, although implementing regulation 2021/1165 permits operators to use previously permitted non-organic agricultural ingredients until 31 December 2023. Derogations to use non-organic agricultural ingredients, where they are not available organically, will last up to 6 months and may be renewed twice, allowing a maximum derogation period of 18 months (Article 25 of Regulation 2018/848). Under the previous regulation, derogations lasted up to 12 months and could be renewed 3 times.
- 10. **Group certification** a collective of small organic operators may obtain group certification. Under the previous regulation, certification was restricted to a single operator.
- 11. **Statement of agricultural origin** The labelling may name a specific country of origin if at least 95% of the ingredients were farmed or grown in that country. This is change from the previous regulation, which required 98% of the ingredients to be farmed or grown in the named country.
- 12. **Natural flavourings** there are new restrictions on the natural flavourings that are permitted. There is also a new requirement to include flavourings within the product percentage calculations.

13. Crop Production

- After 12 months of conversion, seeds and propagating materials (not seedlings) may be marketed as 'in-conversion'.
- Crop rotation is now required to include leguminous crops as a main or cover crop, as well as other green manure crops (with the exception of grassland and perennial forage).

- For greenhouses and perennial crops (other than forage), there is a requirement to include short-term green manure crops and legumes and introduce plant diversity.
- If the same variety of organic and conventional perennial crops are grown or if they are of different varieties but cannot be easily differentiated, the whole area must convert to organic production within 5 years.

14. Livestock production

- The proportion of feed which must come from the farm itself or, if that is not possible, must be produced in the region, remains at 60% initially, but will increase to 70% from 1 January 2024.
- During the second year of conversion, the maximum percentage of conversion feed not originating from the farm is reduced to 25%, compared to 30% under the previous regulation. Farmers may still feed organic livestock on 100% in-conversion feed when the feed is produced on their holding.
- If it is not possible to feed animals with maternal milk, the milk replacer must be 100% organic.
- It will no longer be permitted to carry out the final fattening phase for adult cattle for meat production exclusively indoors.

15. Poultry

- Non-organic pullets (defined as poultry under 18 weeks of age) may no longer be brought into organic flocks unless they are less than three days old.
- For young poultry and young pigs, the option of using 5% non-organic protein feed ends on 31 December 2026.
- Additional rules for livestock are provided in Commission Implementing Regulation 2020/464, including the following requirements for poultry:
 - Requirement that perches and/or raised sitting level should be available not only for laying hens, but for all poultry from an early age (except ducks and geese).
 - New requirements have been introduced allowing the subdivision of poultry houses into compartments to accommodate several batches, which must not be allowed to mix. The requirements differ according to the type of poultry.
 - There are several transitional periods for the requirements around poultry housing. These have various dates by which the new rules must be fully met. The longest transitional measures run until 2030.

SCRUTINY HISTORY

16. The Parliamentary scrutiny history relevant to this Explanatory Memorandum is contained in the attached Annex A.

MINISTERIAL RESPONSIBILITY

17. Responsibility lies with the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs.

INTEREST OF THE DEVOLVED ADMINISTRATIONS

- 18. The Devolved Administrations of Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales were consulted on the production of this EM.
- 19. As an area of agriculture, much of the organics regime is devolved, for example matters relating to support for operators. Areas related to trade and international issues remain reserved matters.

LEGAL AND PROCEDURAL ISSUES

20. The legislation has been adopted and implemented on 1 January 2022.

i. Legal Basis

The legal basis for Regulation 2018/848 is Article 43(2) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union.

ii. Voting Procedure

The UK will not be involved in a voting procedure.

iii. Timetable for adoption and implementation

The new regulation came into force on 1 January 2022. The implementation of Regulation 2018/848 will require new domestic enforcement legislation in NI which is currently being drafted.

POLICY IMPLICATIONS

- 21. Under the Northern Ireland Protocol, EU organic regulations continue to apply directly in NI.
- 22. The Northern Ireland Competent Authority (NICA) for organics currently sits as a separate entity within Defra. Defra officials work closely with their Northern Ireland counterparts on the implementation of Regulation 2018/848.

- 23. Officials from Defra and the NI Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs (DAERA) meet regularly with organic control bodies and port health authorities operating in NI to resolve any technical queries and address industry concerns about the new Regulation.
- 24. Both Defra and DAERA are also working with colleagues in the Republic of Ireland to allow a common approach to organics across the island of Ireland where possible whilst respecting section 46 of the United Kingdom Internal Market Act 2020.
- 25. The implementation of Regulation 2018/848 creates divergence between Northern Ireland and Great Britain, with operators in Great Britain continuing to follow the retained Council Regulation 834/2007 and Commission Regulations 889/2008 and 1235/2008. Due to the Trade and Cooperation Agreement, this will have no impact to trade flows.
- 26. This means that NI operators must meet different standards from GB operators in some areas of organic production.
- 27. In particular, the requirement for organic pullets plus 100% organic poultry feed for older poultry under Regulation 2018/848, rather than 95% under retained Regulation 834/2007, means that NI operators are likely to face negligible higher production costs for eggs compared to their GB counterparts.
- 28. We recognise the impact the Northern Ireland Protocol is having on the ground. The UK Government has been clear for some time that the Protocol has been causing serious problems. That is why we are in negotiations with the EU to work towards a negotiated solution to sort out these very real issues for the people of Northern Ireland. It is perfectly possible for the United Kingdom and EU to work out a solution which delivers for the people of Northern Ireland.

CONSULTATION

29. No consultation has taken place and impact assessment is not within scope.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

30. Minimal financial implications to the industry as there are benefits for industry and many of the changes are introduced over a long phased period. One of the benefits of the new regulations is that it now requires 95% of organic ingredients in processed products compared to 98% of organic ingredients in the old regulation. Pullet rearing houses face additional costs for organic certification which puts them in line with the rest of the organic sector.
