Split site indicator: Inclusion of this new data item will allow schools to more accurately reflect their capacity return.

Net capacity method and date: This data is required because DfE currently does not know the method of calculation local authorities use to determine net capacity, or the date on which capacity was assessed. Therefore, informed judgements cannot be made about the quality and consistency of the data. Identifying local authorities which are having difficulties in maintaining net capacity assessments or using unexpected methods to calculate net capacity will allow us to better focus the data cleaning process.

Amending the valid values will assist developers.
