JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The claim for notice pay succeeds and the Respondent is ordered to pay the gross sum of £91.80 to the Claimant;
- 2. The claim for unpaid wages succeeds and the Respondent is ordered to pay the gross sum of £91.80 to the Claimant;
- 3. The claim for holiday pay succeeds and the Respondent is ordered to pay the gross sum of £107.75 to the Claimant.

The total award is £291.35.

4. The claims of race discrimination, harassment and victimisation are not well founded and are dismissed.
