We refer to our letter of 12 May 2021, in which we provided a partial disclosure of the information you requested pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act). We notified you of an extension of the time limit for the remaining information until 10 June 2021 in order to assess the application of the public interest test, which required information from a third party.

Please find attached at Appendix 1 a list of 40 further contracts that became QDCs by 31 December 2020 and that were notified to the SSRO by 31 January 2021.

There are a further three contracts for which we have provided the information in a part-redacted form contained in Appendix 2. In respect of nine contracts, we confirm that the information is being withheld in its entirety. For both categories, the information withheld is exempt from disclosure under section 26(1)(b) of the Act. The exemption is invoked on the basis that release of the information would prejudice or would be likely to prejudice the capability, effectiveness or security of the armed forces of the Crown. It is considered that disclosure would, or there is a very significant chance that it would, cause risk to the physical safety of armed forces or impairment to their ability to carry out their duties. The exemption relied upon is a 'qualified' exemption and is therefore subject to a public interest test. We have balanced the public interest in disclosing the information against the public interest in protecting the capability, effectiveness and security of the armed forces. Our conclusion is that protecting the armed forces should predominate and the information should be withheld.

There are an additional 10 QDCs for which we hold the relevant information, but which are neither included in the appendices or currently confirmed as being exempt from disclosure. For these contracts the application of the public interest test requires information from a third party, which we are continuing to actively seek. In accordance with section 10(3) of the Act, we are therefore notifying you that the time limit for a response is being extended to 8 July 2021. It is possible that a further extension of time may be required and we will notify you if this is the case.
