JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Employment Tribunal is:

1. The claim of direct discrimination is not well founded and is dismissed.
2. The claim of unfavourable treatment arising from disability is not well founded and is dismissed.
3. The claimant was unfairly dismissed.

Order

1. The case will be listed for a one day remedy hearing to be listed on the first available date after the 1st August 2022.
2. No later than the 5th May 2022 the claimant shall send to the respondent a revised schedule of loss and disclose documents related to his efforts to obtain alternative employment and his income from any employment obtained since his dismissal.
