Cambridge Park Academy Limited: Financial Notice to Improve Closure

On 8 January 2020, Mike Pettifer wrote to you as the Chair of Trustees at Cambridge Park Academy Limited to serve notice that Cambridge Park Academy Limited ('the trust') was required to improve the financial management and governance at the trust.

This was as a consequence of concerns about financial capability, irregularities and declining reserves. The Financial Notice to Improve (FNtI) set out the actions that were needed to be taken by the trust to make sure necessary improvements were made.

We have closely monitored the trust's progress against the conditions set out in the notice. I am pleased to inform you that I am satisfied that the FNtI conditions have now been met. As a result, the FNtI will be closed with effect from the date of this letter.
