Thank you for your email of 11 February 2022 to the Ministry of Defence (MOD) requesting the following information:

"could I please request the Second World War medal entitlement of the following individual, and if possible the date they were issued? Also a copy of his WW2 medal card if issued?

- I believe was recommissioned from the Army Officers Emergency Reserve on 2 September 1939. officer number was 98046. relinquished his commission on 28 April 1948, having exceeded the age limit."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

I can confirm that the medal entitlement for the second is as follows:

- Defence Medal
- War Medal

The medals were both issued on 27 September 1948. As requested, please also find a copy of CS20 Medal Card at Annex A.
