JUDGMENT

Upon consideration of the Claims of Disability Discrimination set out at paragraphs 5.1, 5.3, 5.5 and 5.7 of EJ Harding's Order dated 15 April 2021 and in light of the Respondent's application to strike out each of those claims on the basis that they had no reasonable prospect of success or that they should be the subject of a Deposit Order because they had little reasonable prospect of success:

- 1. The Claim at paragraph 5.3 is struck out as having no reasonable prospect of success.
- 2. The Claims at 5.1. 5.5 and 5.7 shall continue for consideration at a final hearing and the Respondent's applications as aforesaid in respect of those heads of claim are dismissed.
- 3. The Respondent concedes that at least one of the three remaining acts between March 2019 and 10 March 2020 has been lodged within the statutory time limit and further accepts that those acts can properly be described as acts extending over a period.
- 4. All claims not detailed within paragraphs 5-8 of EJ Harding's Order dated 15 April 2021 shall be dismissed upon withdrawal. The Claimant may use those matters as background to the remaining claims if relevant.
