

"I have recently purchased an ex-military Land rover defender 110 I have checked the released MERLIN database and the vehicle service history is not contained in the available published MERLIN extract (the vehicle as having only recently come out of service). Therefore I submit a FOI request for the following information:

Vehicle military service history (Units served etc, as contained in MERLIN/james)
Any Maintenance Records / Work objects related to this vehicle.

Vehicle Registration: MV33AA

VIN number: SALLDBA68VA131222."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, but I regret to advise that no information within the scope of your request is held.

However, under Section 16 of the FOI Act (Advice and Assistance) I can advise you that it is possible the Royal Logistic Corps Museum archives might hold some information relating to your vehicle. The Archives contain a wealth of digitised Corps Journals, enlistments books, diaries, photographs and vehicle records.
