### II.1 Public health attestation

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that:

- II.1.1** (a) the bumble bees (*Bombus* spp.) referred to in Part I of this certificate have been bred and kept under a controlled environment within a recognised establishment which is supervised and controlled by the competent authority;
- (b) the establishment referred to in Part I of this certificate was inspected immediately prior to dispatch and all bumble bees and breeding stock show no clinical signs or suspicion of disease including infestations affecting bees;
- (c) all colonies for import into Great Britain have undergone detailed examination to ensure that all bumble bees, broodstock and packaging do not contain the small hive beetle (*Aethina tumida*) or its eggs and larvae or other infestations in particular *Tropilaelaps* spp., affecting bees;
- II.1.2** the packing material, containers, accompanying products and food are new and have not been in contact with diseased bees or brood-combs, and all precautions have been taken to prevent contamination with agents causing diseases or infestations of bees.
