## JUDGMENT

This is the unanimous judgment of the tribunal:

- 1. The respondent discriminated against the claimant because of something arising in consequence of his disability.
- 2. The respondent discriminated against the claimant by failing to make adjustments.
- 3. The claimant's remedy will be assessed on the basis that, had the respondent not discriminated against the claimant, the claimant's assignment would inevitably have terminated immediately following one week's work.
