Designation (No.2) under the Health Protection (Coronavirus, Wearing of Face Coverings) (England) Regulations 2021

The Secretary of State makes the following designations, in relation to England, with immediate effect, in exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 11(9)(d) and 14(c) of the Health Protection (Coronavirus, Wearing of Face Coverings) (England) Regulations 2021^a (“the Regulations”):

Enforcement: fixed penalty notices

1. For the purposes of regulation 11(9)(d) of the Regulations, the Secretary of State hereby designates each specified authority as an “authorised person” who, (under regulation 11(1) and subject to regulation 11(11)), may issue a fixed penalty notice to anyone that the authorised person reasonably believes has committed an offence under regulation 6 of the Regulations, or in contravention of the prohibition in regulation 7(1) of the Regulations.


Prosecutions

2. For the purposes of regulation 14(c) each specified authority is designated as a person who may bring proceedings for an offence in contravention of the requirements in regulation 6 of the Regulations, or contravention of the prohibition in regulation 7(1) of the Regulations.

Specified Authorities

3. For the purposes of these designations, a “specified authority” means—

- (a) a district council;
- (b) a county council;
- (c) a London borough council;
- (d) the Common Council of the City of London in its capacity as a local authority;
- (e) the Council of the Isles of Scilly.
