Reason for change (including benefits)

Background

There are many circumstances why a child may be known to their local authorities children's services. The one thing that all these circumstances have in common is that all children known to children services is that they are notably behind their peers on many aspects of their education journey, lower rates of and attainment than their peers.

Data on all these circumstances can be either unreliable or too infrequent for use by many stakeholders providing support to those children. The circumstance that's been identified as least reliable are those Children With a Social Worker (CWSW) that aren't a Looked After Child (LAC, as known as CLA) and Previously Looked After Children (PLAC). These children are known as Children In Need (CIN). These children can be SEND, on a CIN Plan or Children Protection Plan (CPP) and a number of other reasons.

The department has identified that these children should be easily identifiable on school records. The most logical place for this is the school register / roll.

Proposal

That all data systems available to schools contain markers for LAC, PLAC, CIN and CPP. This includes school register / roll products.
