Thank you for your request for information which was processed in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

You requested the following information:

Freedom of Information Request re: 10 Green Hill, Brackenhall, Huddersfield HD2 1TU Please would you let me know if this property, or the development of which the property forms a part, received public funding, and if so what type of public funding?

Response

<u>Neither Confirm nor Deny</u> Homes England can neither confirm nor deny that we hold the information requested.

On receipt of a valid request for information, section 1(1) of the FOIA obliges a public authority to inform the requestor under section 1(a) if they hold the information requested, and under section 1(b) communicate that information to them.

However, the duty under section(1)(a) does not apply to your request by virtue of sections 40(2) FOIA. The request refers to a specific address which could identify an individual. The duty to confirm or deny does not arise if to comply with this duty constitutes third party personal data and would breach one or more of the data protection principles (section 40(2)).

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Right to Appeal

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If you are not happy with the information that has been provided or the way in which your request has been handled, you may request an internal review. Your request for review must be made in writing, explain why you wish to appeal, and be received within 40 working days of the date of this response. Failure to meet this criteria may lead to your request being refused.

Upon receipt, your request for review will be passed to an independent party not involved in your original request. We aim to issue a response within 20 working days.

You may also complain to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) however, the Information Commissioner does usually expect the internal review procedure to be exhausted in the first instance.
