Freedom of Information Requests

Thank you for your emails of 6 September 2021 where you requested the following information:

“Please send me the total costs for home working equipment for officials in your department since March 2020”; and

“Please send me a list of all items for home working in your department since March 2020 which cost more than £1,000.”

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'), you have the right to:

- know whether we hold the information you require
- be provided with that information (subject to any exemptions under the Act which may apply).

The Trade Remedies Authority (TRA) was established on 1 June 2021 through the Trade Act. We do not hold the requested information prior to this date.

We can confirm that the total cost for home working equipment for officials in the TRA since 1 June 2021 to the date your request was received is £2,176.24.

No home working items costing more than £1,000 have been purchased since 1 June 2021.

Appeals procedure

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original request and should be addressed to the Knowledge and Information Management Team:
