## JUDGMENT OF THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNAL

1. For the reasons given in an oral judgment, the Second Respondent was the employer of the claimant.

- 2. The Second Respondent has failed to enter a response to the claim and judgment is entered for the claimant (rule 21).
- 3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent is ordered to pay damages to the claimant in the sum of £2,575.38
- 5 4. The claimant as dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of £9,417.60.
  - 5. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £311.15.
