JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

REASONS

1. This case was presented to the Employment Tribunal in Scotland on 23 August 2021. By an Order dated 10 January 2022 the claimant was informed that the case had been transferred to the North West region of the Employment Tribunals in England and Wales.
2. The claimant is prohibited from continuing these proceedings in England without the permission of the High Court following an order made in the High Court sealed on 24 July 2007 in case number CO/3134/2006.
3. By letter of 27 January 2022 the claimant was warned that if permission to proceed were to be refused by the High Court the claim would be struck out.
4. In fact, by an Order sealed on 26 January 2022 in case number CO/3913/2021 the High Court had already refused the claimant permission to pursue these proceedings.
5. That means that these proceedings now amount to an abuse of process. Accordingly they are struck out under rule 37(1)(a) (because there is no real prospect of success where the claim cannot proceed) and/or rule 37(1)(e) (because a fair hearing of the claim is no longer possible given that it cannot proceed).
