## **JUDGMENT**

The complaint of **failure to pay a redundancy payment** is struck out.

## REASONS

- 1. By a letter dated 23 March 2022 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the complaint of failure to pay a redundancy payment should not be struck out because it
  - Under Sections 163 & 177 of the Employment Rights Act 1997 Claimants are not entitled to bring a complaint of failure to pay a redundancy payment unless they were employed for two years or more.
  - The Claimant was employed for less than two years.
- 2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The complaint of **failure to pay a redundancy payment** is therefore struck out.
- 3. The claimant's remaining claim(s) remains listed for hearing on 9 September 2022.
