






## **Overview**

1.31 million individuals were prosecuted or given an out of court disposal in 2020






#### Number of individuals (in thousands) who were:




## **Out of court disposals**

Out of court disposals continue to decrease, whilst community resolutions remain 25% higher than 2019.




## **Prosecutions and convictions**

**1.11 million** defendants were **prosecuted** at magistrates' courts in 2021, 16% more than 2020, but still 19% fewer that 2019.




## Remands

## Sentencing

The number of offenders sentenced at all courts rose by 18% in the latest year to 962,000, remaining 19% lower than 2019.

## Motoring

Prosecutions and convictions for motoring offences increased by 22% each over the last year, with sentencing following the same trend.
