2. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £634.61 gross.
3. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant £444.23.
4. The respondent must pay the claimant **£3,964.04 gross**.
