JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's claim for unauthorised deductions from wages succeeds in part, following the Respondent's concession.
- 2. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the sum of £2,221.46. This is a gross sum and the Claimant is required to account for any income tax and/or national insurance contributions which may be due on it.
- 3. The Claimant's claim for unauthorised deductions from wages concerning the RX Compliance Deductions and holiday pay are dismissed following the Claimant's withdrawal of these claims.
