JUDGMENT

The complaint seeking a declaration as to **entitlement to a statutory redundancy payment** is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. By a letter dated the 8th of April 2022 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the complaint seeking entitlement to a statutory redundancy payment should not be struck out because:
 - Under Sections 163 & 177 of the Employment Rights Act 1997 Claimants are not entitled to bring a complaint of failure to pay a redundancy payment unless they were employed for two years or more.
 - The Claimant was employed for less than two years.
- 2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The complaint of **entitlement to a statutory redundancy payment** is therefore struck out.
- 3. The claimant's remaining claim(s) remains listed for hearing
