#### IV. Health information

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, certify that the animals described above meet the following requirements:

(a) the United Kingdom is free from the following notifiable diseases in accordance with the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE) Terrestrial Animal Health Code:

- African swine fever (ASF);
- classical swine fever (CSF);
- swine vesicular disease (SVD);
- foot and mouth disease (FMD);
- enterovirus encephalomyelitis (Teschovirus encephalomyelitis, Teschen disease);
- porcine brucellosis (*Brucella suis*).

Vaccination against these diseases is not permitted in the United Kingdom;

(b) the premises of origin are not situated in an area/zone subject to official restrictions due to a notifiable disease to which pigs are susceptible;

(c) the animals described above were born and reared entirely in the United Kingdom;

(d) within 21 days prior to the date of export, blood and nasal swabs taken from the pigs described above were sent to Government-approved laboratories and subjected to the following tests with negative results, which are attached to this certificate;

(i) they will be transported directly to the airport/port of shipment in the UK in containers/vehicles previously cleansed and disinfected with an approved disinfectant;

(ii) they will be transported without coming into contact with any animals other than those meeting the requirements of this certificate;

(iii) they will be transported to their destination safely and humanely in accordance with the Live Animal Regulations of the International Air Transport Association (IATA).
