JUDGMENT

Rule 21 Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013

1. The claim was not presented within the relevant time limit. It was not reasonably practicable for it to have been presented within the time limit and it was presented within a further reasonable period.

2. The Tribunal has jurisdiction to consider the following complaints:

Unfair dismissal Breach of contract Unlawful deduction of wages Failure to pay holiday pay Failure to provide written terms and conditions of employment.

3. It is this Tribunal's judgment that those claims are well-founded. The claimant succeeds in his complaints.

4. The claimant is entitled to a remedy for his successful complaints. The Tribunal will issue a separate remedy judgment in this matter.
