• St John Fisher Catholic Primary School, **Essex**, to join Our Lady of Fatima Catholic Trust **Essex**, part of the diocese of **Brentwood**.

Significant Changes

• Heybridge Co-operative Academy, **Essex**, to move to a new build on another site, which **Essex** County Council (ECC) has proposed to provide and fund, as part of their SEND capital programme, to develop and enhance the PRU Estate across **Essex**.
