## **JUDGMENT**

## Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 Rules 53 and 56

- 1. The complaint about notice pay is dismissed upon its withdrawal by the claimant.
- The claimant shall be permitted to amend her claim to include a complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages in respect of overtime worked on Saturday 8 May 2021.
- 3. The complaint of wrongful dismissal in relation to an allegation of breach of contractual procedures is struck out.
- 4. The complaint of direct age discrimination is struck out.
- 5. The claimant's application to amend her claim to include a complaint of harassment because of age is refused.
- 6. The remaining 2 complaints, of unauthorised deductions from wages and of a failure to allow the claimant to be accompanied at the meeting at which she was dismissed, shall proceed to a final hearing listed on **26 September 2022**, subject to the Deposit Order in respect of the complaint of a failure to allow the claimant to

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be accompanied to the dismissal meeting, (which shall be issued separately to this Judgment).
