- c) The slaughterhouse(s), cutting plant(s), processing plant(s) and cold store(s) at Section II above are not subject to animal health restrictions arising from notifiable diseases under applicable UK legislation;
- d) the commodity has been dressed, prepared and packed under hygienic conditions in accordance with applicable UK legislation;
- e) no substances derived from other animal species (e.g. bovine, ovine or porcine proteins) have been added to this meat;
- f) the commodity originates from poultry not slaughtered as part of a disease eradication program/measure;
- g) the commodity is considered fit for human consumption;
- h) the proposed means of transport and container are suitable to ensure the safe transit of the commodity. The container was cleaned and disinfected prior to loading;
- i) the commodity did not test positive for Salmonella, Listeria monocytogenes, E. coli, Campylobacter jejuni.
