JUDGMENT

- (1) The Claimant's complaint of breach of contract in relation to 14 hours' furlough pay is well-founded, and the Respondent is hereby ordered to pay to the Claimant damages in the sum of £122.08, subject to any deductions for tax and National Insurance required by law.
- (2) The Claimant's complaint of failure to pay accrued and outstanding holiday pay at termination, in the amount of 23.73 hours, is well-founded, and the Respondent is hereby ordered to pay to the Claimant compensation in the sum of £206.92, subject to any deductions for tax and National Insurance required by law.
