JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's complaint of unfair dismissal is well-founded and succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay compensation to the claimant for unfair dismissal in the sum of £1,967.00.
- 2. The claimant's complaint of breach of contract (failure to pay notice pay) is well-founded and succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant in respect of wages in lieu of notice the sum of £500.00.
- 3. The claimant's complaint of unlawful deduction from wages is well-founded and succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £247.76 in respect of wages unlawfully deducted. That is a net amount and the respondent shall be responsible for the payment of any income tax and national insurance contributions thereon.
- 4. The claimant's complaint of unauthorised deduction from wages (failure to pay accrued holiday pay) is well-founded and succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £75.00 in respect of accrued holiday pay. That is a net amount and the respondent shall be responsible for the payment of any income tax and national insurance contributions thereon.
