Subject: Completion Errors on WP08 forms when raising a compliance doubt

Background

DWP Labour Market Decision Makers are advising that some Work Programme Provider staff is annotating their own personal work email address to the WP08 compliance doubt form, which causes issues for Benefit Centre staff in identifying the email address to which the decision should be returned.

Summary and action

Work Programme Providers to ensure that the Decision Making and Appeal referral form WP08, used to raise a compliance doubt, contains the generic Provider email address as the return descriptor. Work Programme Provider staff and those of their Supply Chain should be reminded not to personalise the WP08 return email address at the bottom of the WP08.
