THE CONFERENCE

The ETF hosted the Policy that Works Conference from 28th February – 3rd March 2022.

The conference was open to all Civil Servants and featured presentations, panel events and workshops designed to support good quality policy evaluation and evidence use across government. Civil servants were encouraged to strive for high quality evidence to support decision making in policy, leading to the best possible outcomes for the public.

BACKGROUND



Analysis undertaken by the Cabinet Office, the Treasury and Behavioural Insights Team found only 8% of government spending on major projects had robust evaluation plans in 2019.¹



The government currently spends around £1 trillion of taxpayers' money a year.²
