JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the employment tribunal is that:

1. It is declared that the claimant's complaint of breach of contract is well founded and is upheld. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £4,887.82 gross (less appropriate deductions for tax and national insurance contributions) by way of compensation for unpaid notice pay.
2. The claimant confirmed at the hearing that he did not intend to bring claims of unfair dismissal or for a redundancy payment and those claims are dismissed upon withdrawal.
