JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's claim for unfair dismissal is struck out as the Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear it.
- 2. The Claimant's claim for holiday pay in July/August 2021 is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 3. The Claimant's claim for holiday pay for December 2020 and older are struck out as they were presented out of time and the Tribunal has no jurisdiction to hear them.
- 4. The Claimant's claim for breach of s8 Employment Rights Act 1996 in connection with her itemised pay statement (payslips) is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 5. There are no other complaints the Claimant brings which the Tribunal has jurisdiction to hear.
