JUDGMENT

1. The Claimant's claim for unfair dismissal is struck out as the Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear it.
2. The Claimant's claim for holiday pay in July/August 2021 is not well founded and is dismissed.
3. The Claimant's claim for holiday pay for December 2020 and older are struck out as they were presented out of time and the Tribunal has no jurisdiction to hear them.
4. The Claimant's claim for breach of s8 Employment Rights Act 1996 in connection with her itemised pay statement (payslips) is not well founded and is dismissed.
5. There are no other complaints the Claimant brings which the Tribunal has jurisdiction to hear.
